Announcements:

SP: BC still has not paid for one of the dumpster services required for his abandoned trash. The title for the house is being transferred. The mailbox has been installed.

NJ: WJ has cancelled the PO Box and submitted an address change card. After a few phone calls by NJ, it was discovered that GSP is in Orlando, KY, according to Rockcastle 911.
