#### **Miscellaneous Property Maintenance**

The tractor is limping along. It may not be available for use even during KOR. Please contact Scott Pavey to confirm the operability of the tractor before use. Bush hogging and mowing the back field are the first priority. A repair is scheduled for October.

The gutters at the ticket house are fixed and draining. We will resume renovations after KOR.

The Atlas Pillar electric panel has rusted beyond repair. WJ will search for a new panel that will last at least 30 years in this high humidity environment. WJ will develop a list of requirements – generically they might include: 200 amp incoming capacity (minimum 100 amp) 24-40 spaces (although we only have about 12 active circuits); non-metallic or stainless steel NEMA 3R cabinet. Contact Werner if you want to be involved in this, it might happen later this summer or fall to winter.

The hot tub will be ready for KOR!

James Clements is waiting on someone to buy the other half of the shingles for the roof for the Showerhouse. JC says it would cost less than \$350 for the shingles. FB made a motion for GSP to cover the cost (less than \$350) and authorize James to get the material from Lumber King.

We still need to replace PR3, in the upper parking lot. It's aging out and the water pressure is getting too high. WJ has a quote. Watch for emails from him on this topic.
